Bi-directional ESD protection device, 18 V (AC), 13 V (DC), 0.3 pF, 01005

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## Product description

This Infineon ESD (electrostatic discharge) protection device has a bi-directional and symmetric  $I/V$  characteristic and excellent clamping performance.

## Feature list

- ESD / transient protection according to:
  - IEC61000-4-2 (ESD):  $\pm 15$  kV (air) /  $\pm 15$  kV (contact)
  - IEC61000-4-4 (EFT):  $\pm 2$  kV /  $\pm 40$  A (5/50 ns)
  - IEC61000-4-5 (Surge):  $\pm 2$  A (8/20  $\mu$ s)
- Bi-directional maximum working voltage:  $V_{WM} = \pm 18$  V (AC),  $\pm 13$  V (DC)
- Line capacitance:  $C_L = 0.3$  pF at  $f = 1$  MHz
- Clamping voltage:  $V_{cl} = 32$  V at  $I_{TLP} = 16$  A with  $R_{dyn} = 0.82 \Omega$
- Very low leakage current:  $I_L = 1$  nA
- Small form factor SMD size 01005, low profile (0.43 x 0.23 x 0.15 mm<sup>3</sup>)



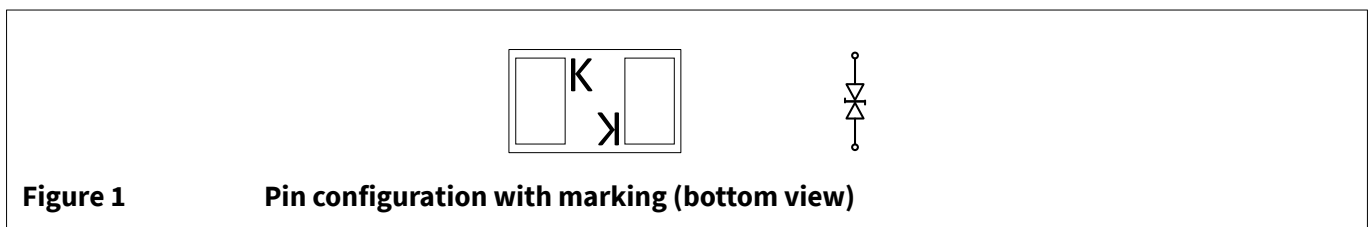

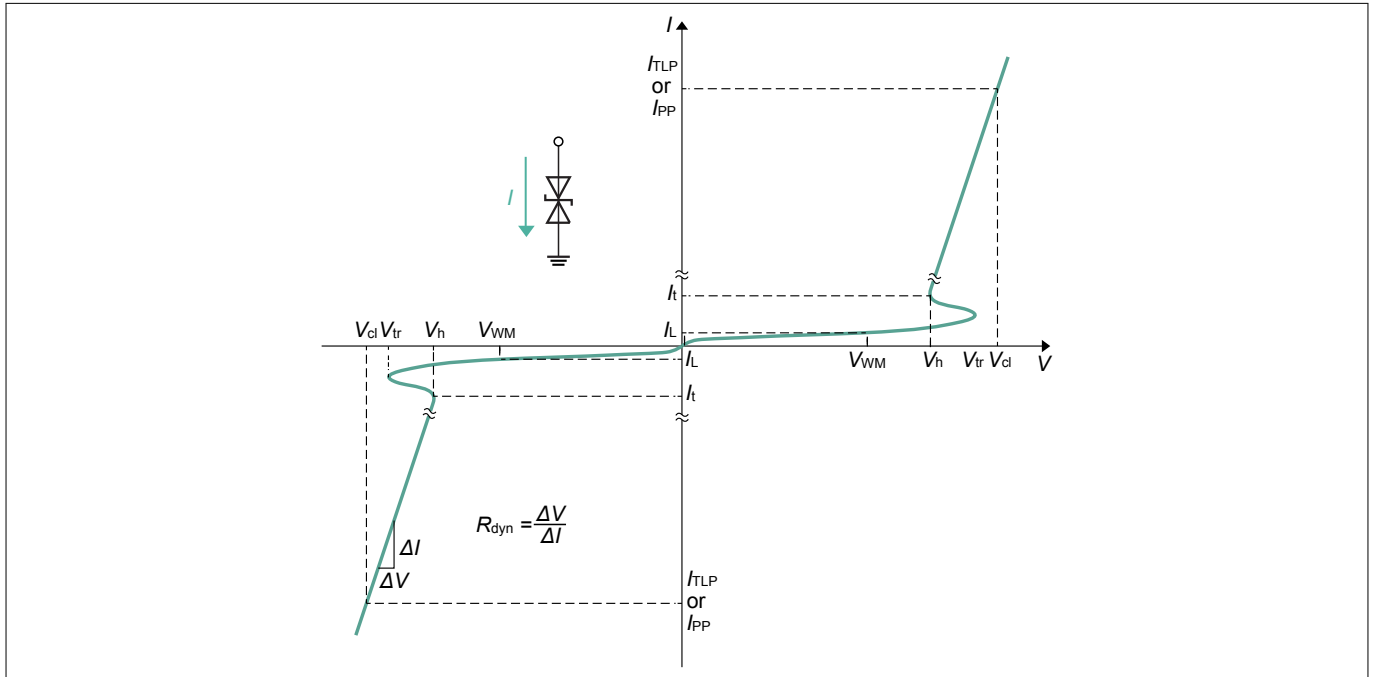

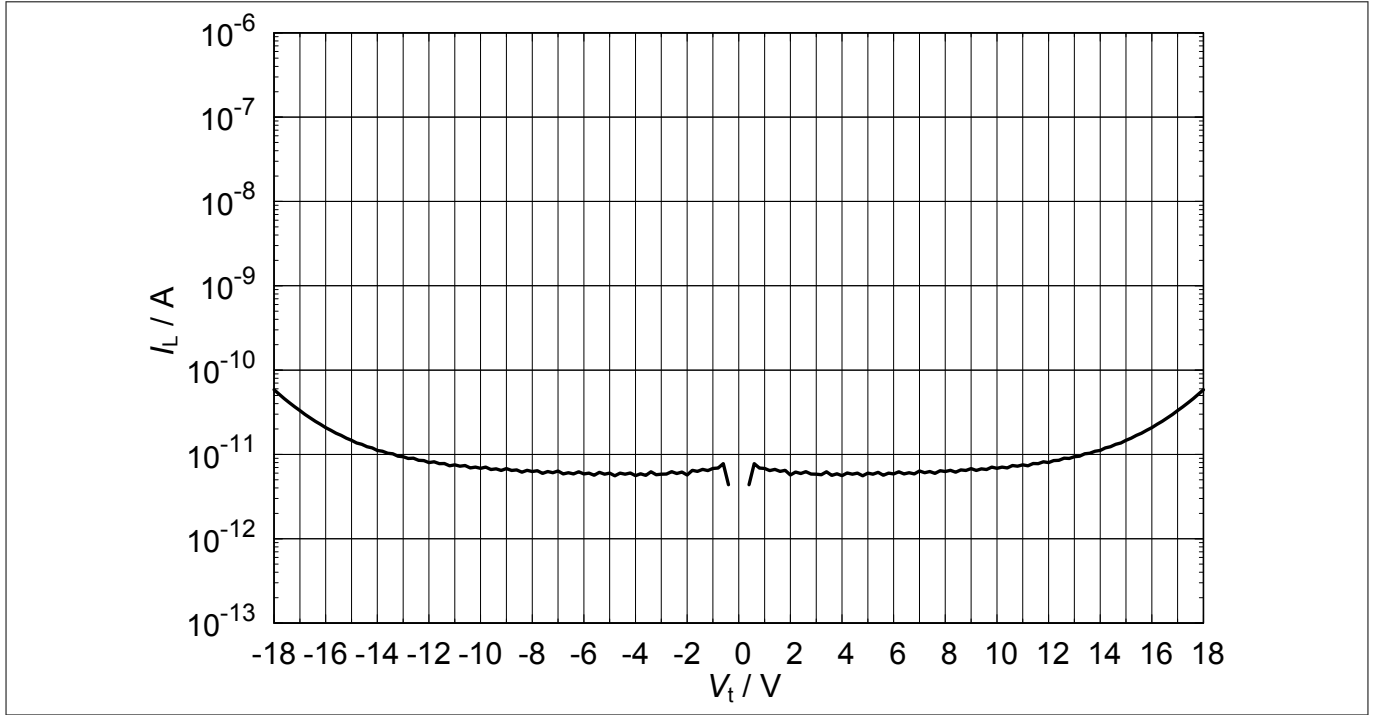


Figure 3 Leakage current:  $I_L = f(V_t)$

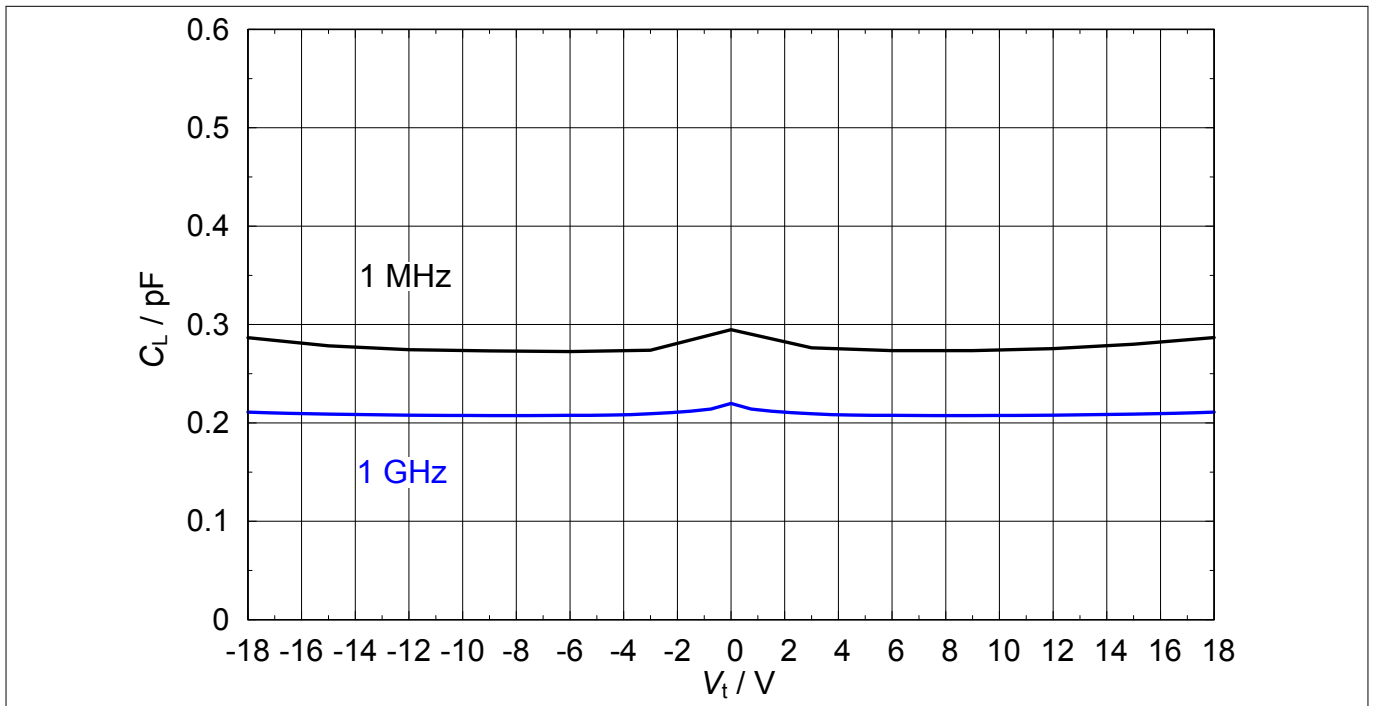


Figure 4 Line capacitance:  $C_L = f(V_t)$ ,  $f = 1\text{ MHz}, 1\text{ GHz}$

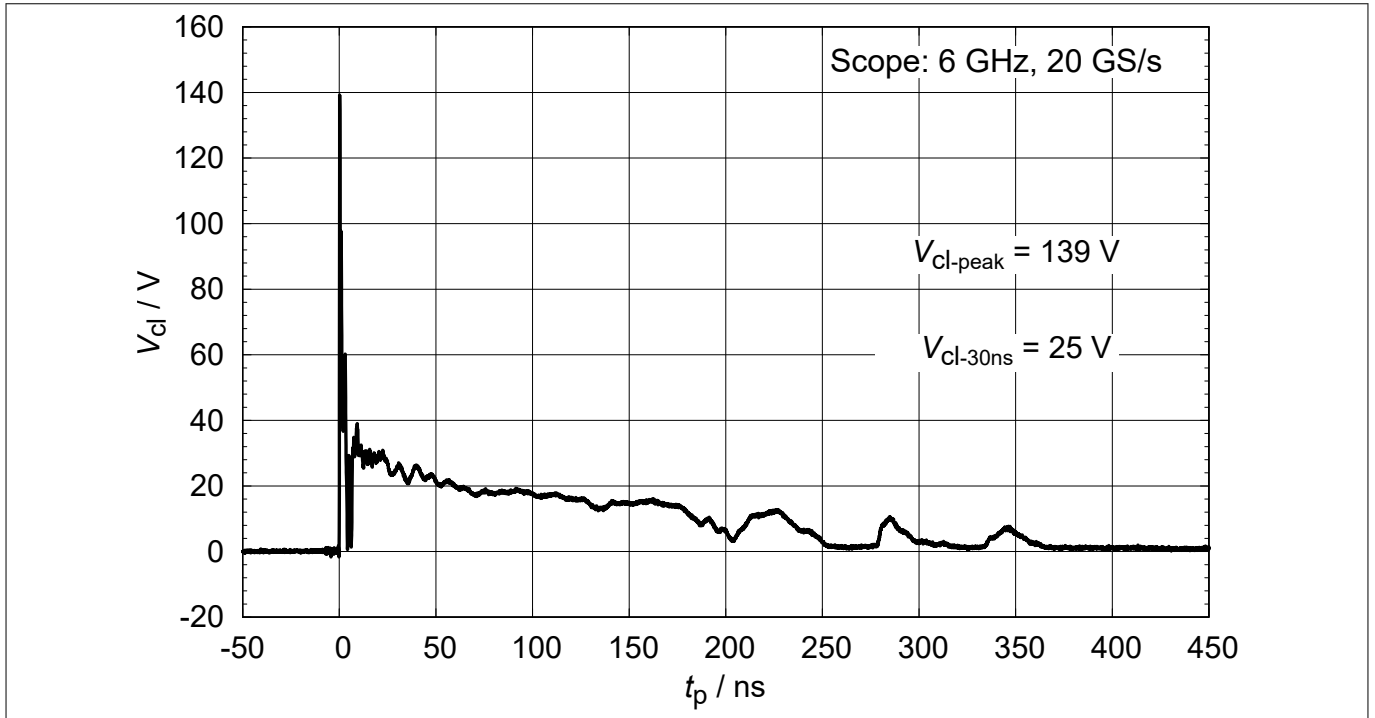


Figure 5 Clamping voltage (ESD):  $V_{cl} = f(t_p)$ , 8 kV positive pulse based on IEC61000-4-2

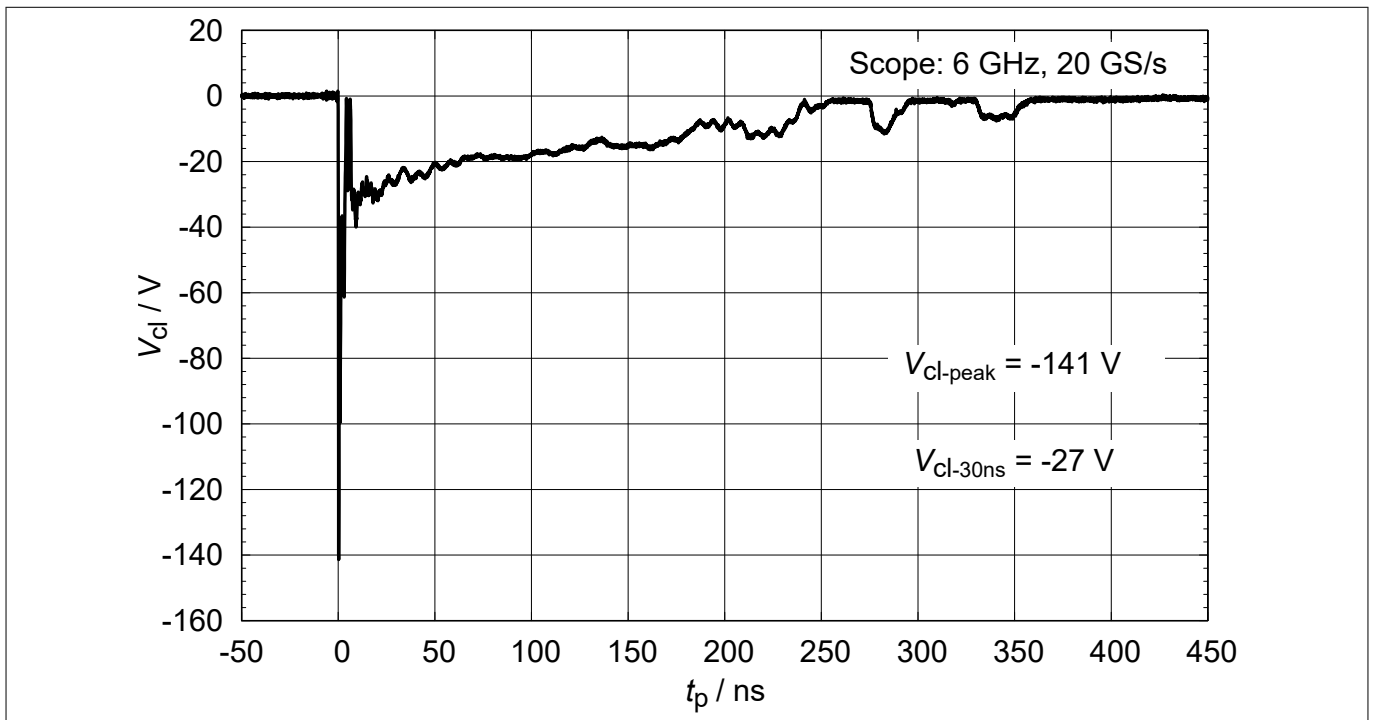


Figure 6 Clamping voltage (ESD):  $V_{cl} = f(t_p)$ , 8 kV negative pulse based on IEC61000-4-2

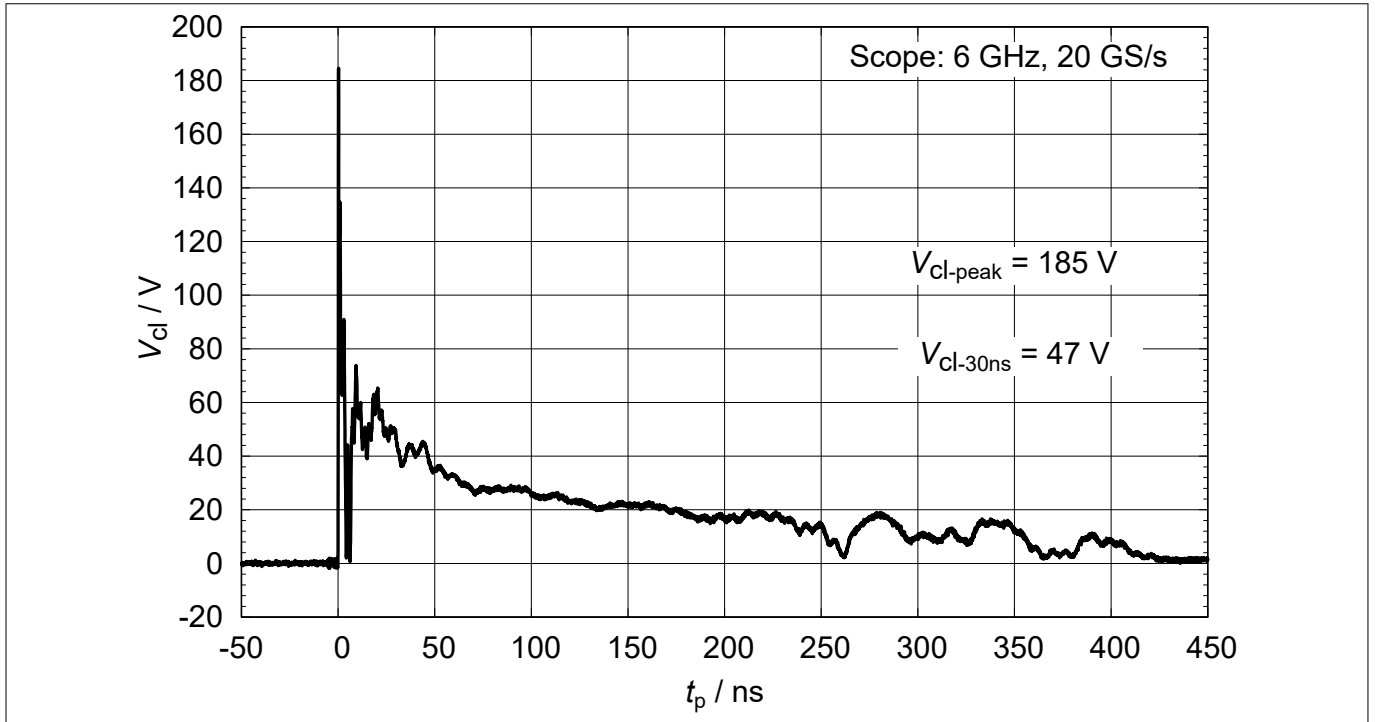


Figure 7 Clamping voltage (ESD):  $V_{cl} = f(t_p)$ , 15 kV positive pulse based on IEC61000-4-2

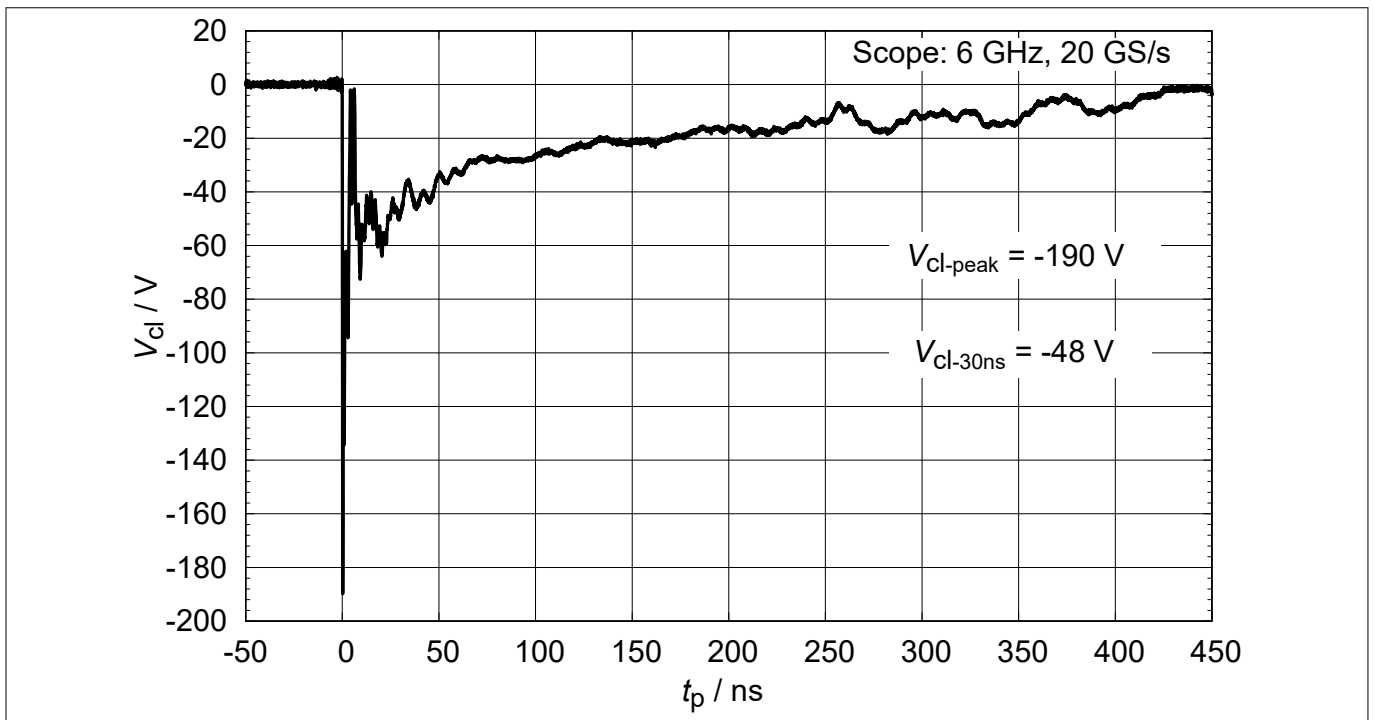
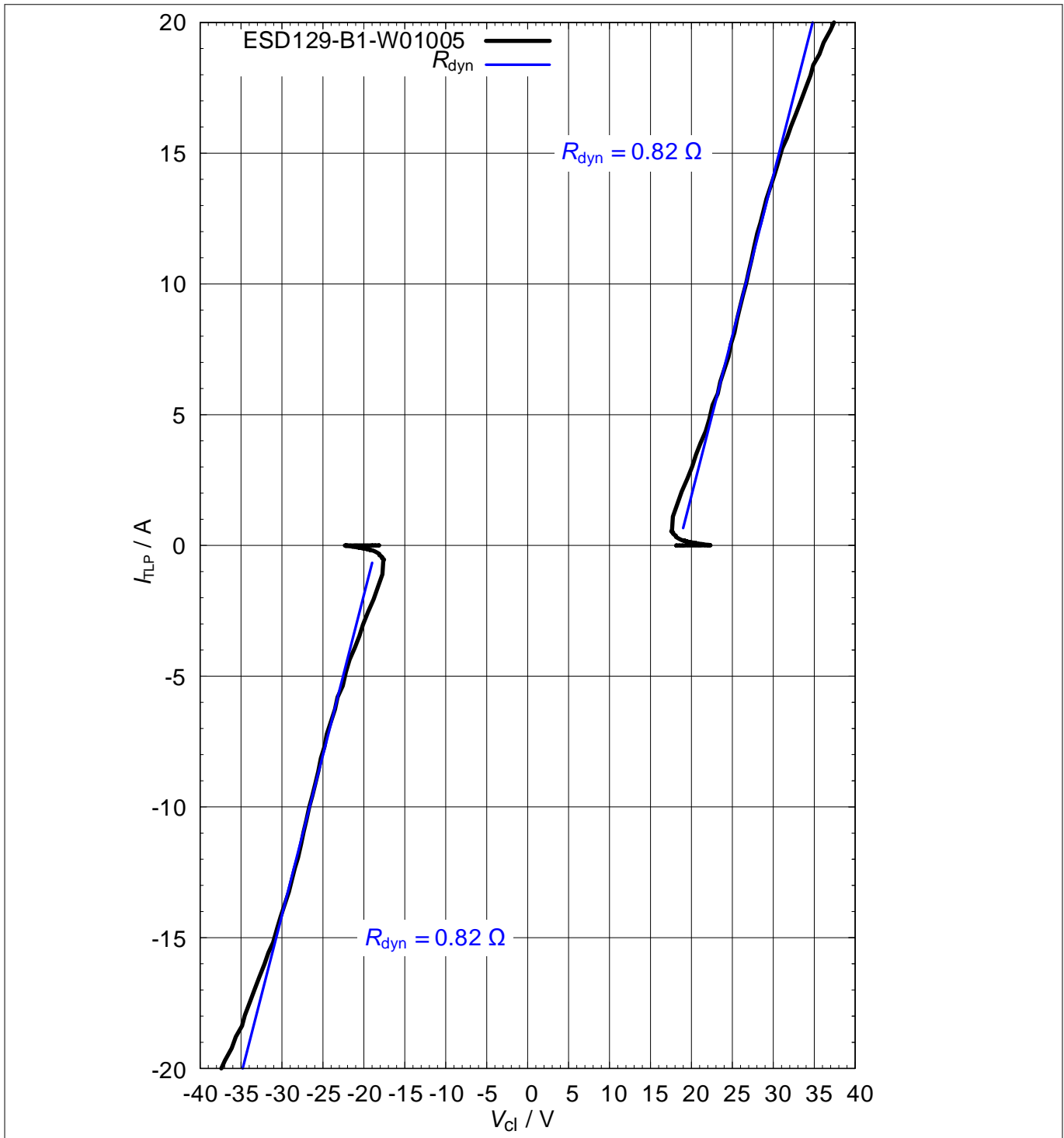


Figure 8 Clamping voltage (ESD):  $V_{cl} = f(t_p)$ , 15 kV negative pulse based on IEC61000-4-2

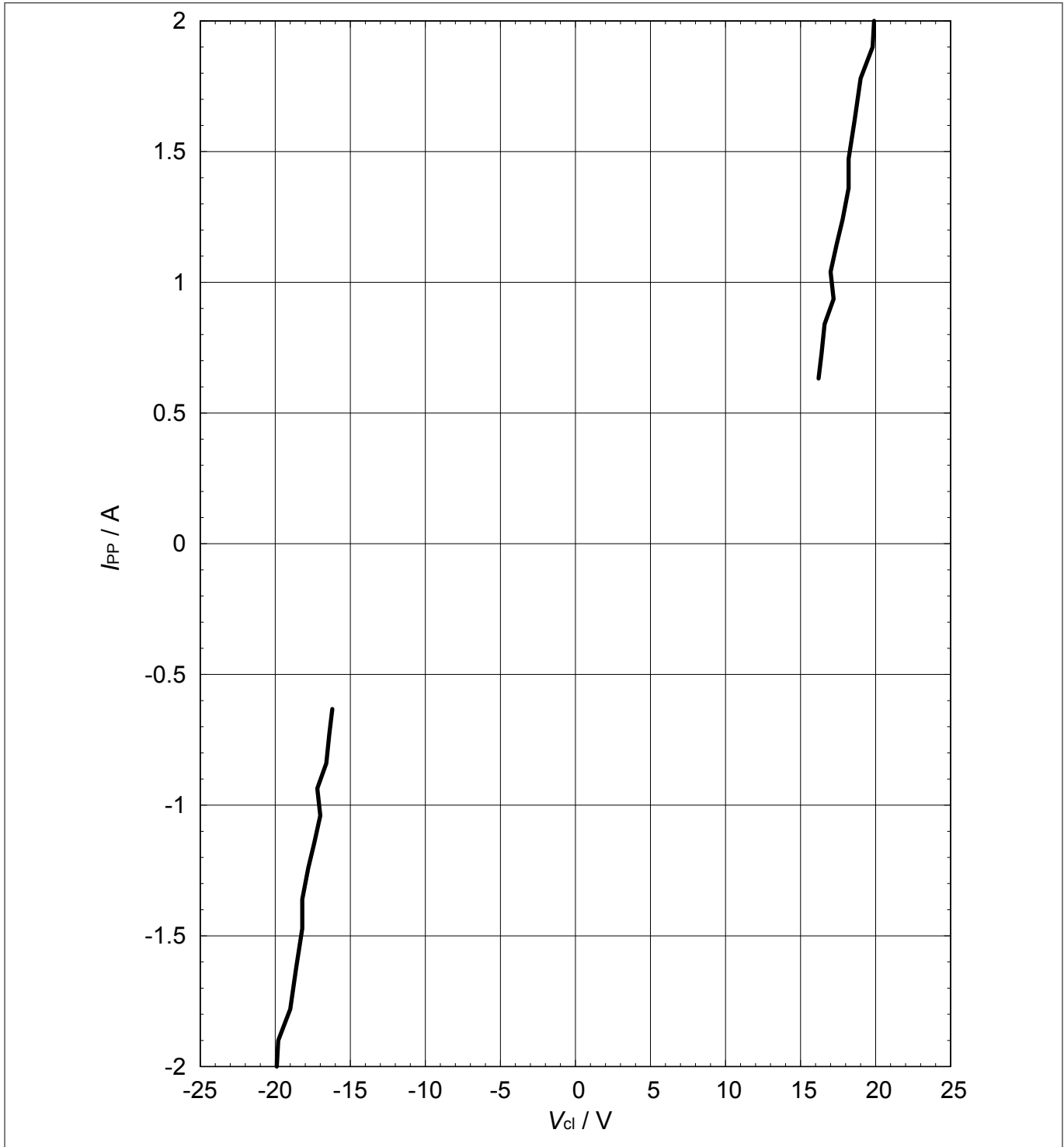

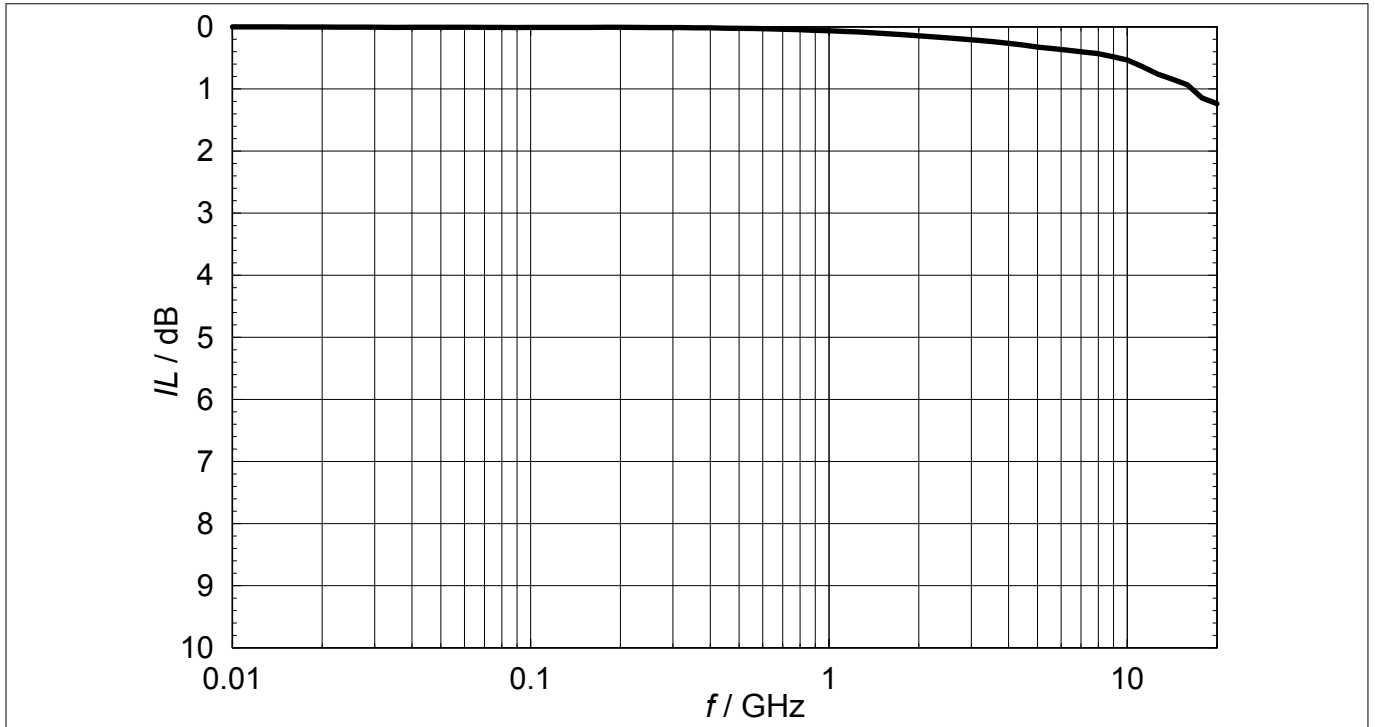


Figure 11 Insertion loss  $IL = f(f)$ , measured in a 50  $\Omega$  system

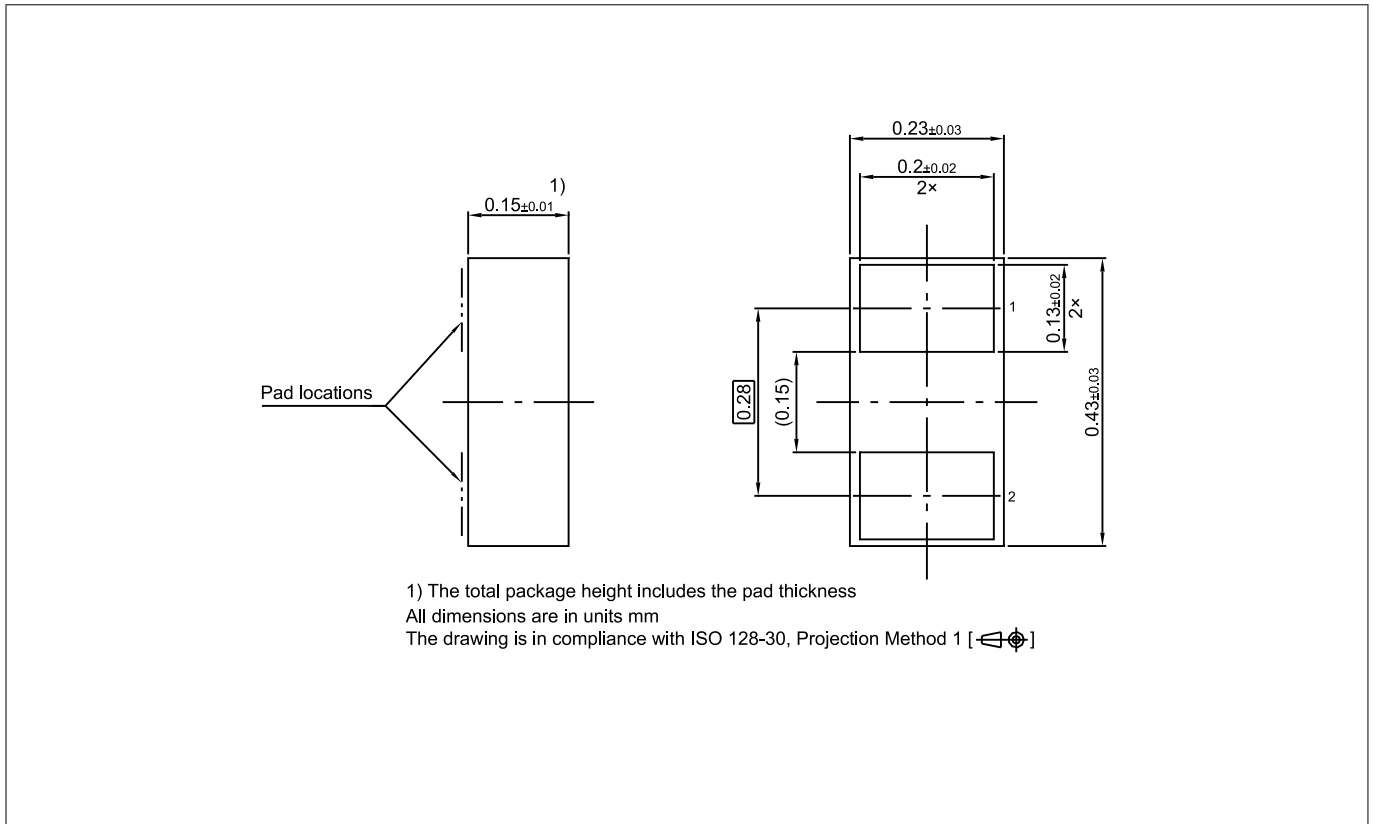


Figure 12 WLL-2-2 package
