

DESCRIPTION

APPLICATION CIRCUITS

The Si3861BDV includes a P- and N-Channel MOSFET in a single TSOP-6 package. The low on-resistance P-Channel TrenchFET[®] is tailored for use as a load switch. The N-Channel, with an external resistor, can be used as a levelshift to drive the P-Channel load-switch. The N-Channel MOSFET has internal ESD protection and can be driven by logic signals as low as 1.5 V. The Si3861DV operates on supply lines from 4.5 to 20 V, and can drive loads up to 2.3 A.




