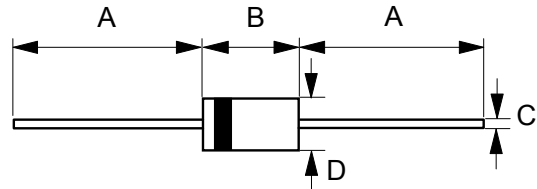

FIG.1- FORWARD CURRENT DERATING CURVE

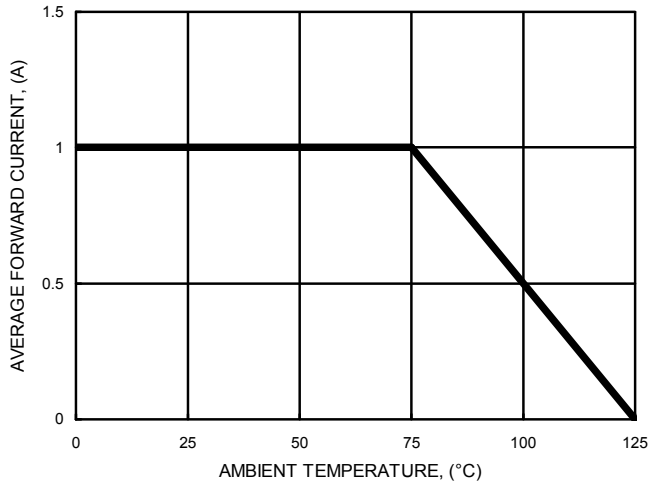


FIG.2- MAXIMUM NON-REPETITIVE SURGE CURRENT

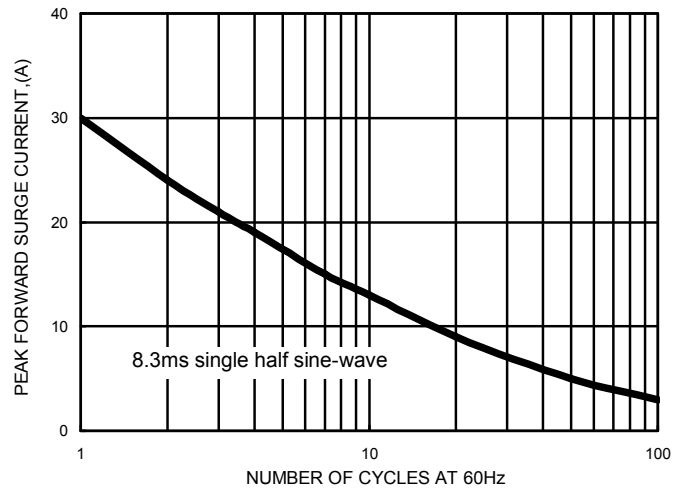


FIG.3- TYPICAL FORWARD CHARACTERISTICS

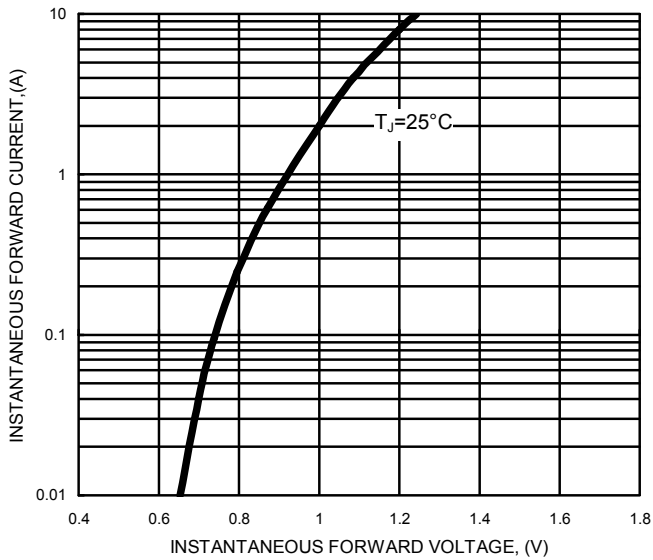
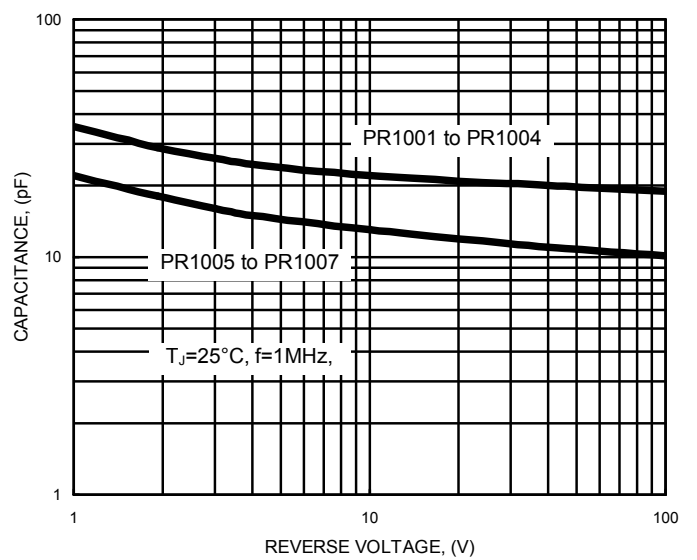


FIG.4- TYPICAL JUNCTION CAPACITANCE



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
