

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


Figure 21. IGBT Transient Thermal Impedance


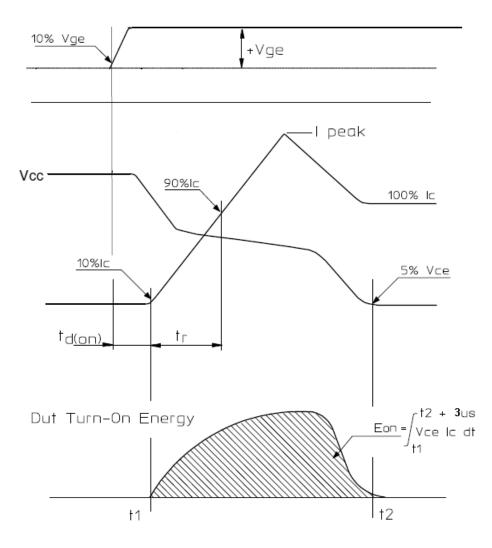



Figure 22. Test Circuit for Switching Characteristics






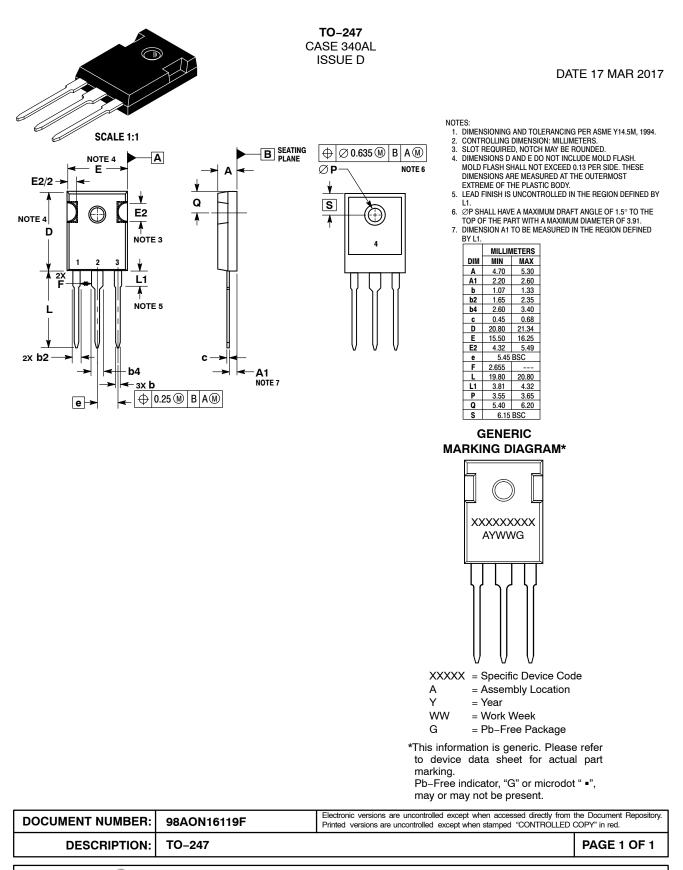


Figure 24. Definition of Turn Off Waveform
