




Figure 1. Pin Connections




Figure 3. Normalized V_{GS} versus Quiescent Current and Case Temperature








Figure 6. Output Power versus Input Power






Figure 8. Power Gain versus Output Power





Figure 11. Narrowband Series Equivalent Source and Load Impedance — 1400 MHz




