


# On-Resistance vs. Drain Current and Gate Voltage






On-Resistance vs. Junction Temperature






#### Source-Drain Diode Forward Voltage




**Threshold Voltage** 



On-Resistance vs. Gate-to-Source Voltage




Single Pulse Power (Junction-to-Ambient)




Safe Operating Area, Junction-to-Ambient






## **Power Derating**

#### Note




Normalized Thermal Transient Impedance, Junction-to-Ambie

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

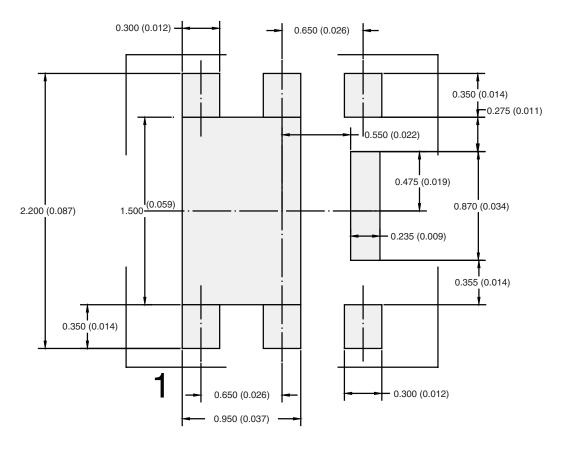
