Normalized Thermal Transient Impedance, Junction-to-Ambient





Normalized Thermal Transient Impedance, Junction-to-Case











On-Resistance vs. Gate-to-Source Voltage



Single Pulse Power












CHANNEL-2 TYPICAL CHARACTERISTICS (25 °C, unless otherwise noted)




Normalized Thermal Transient Impedance, Junction-to-Ambient













TOP SIDE VIEW


