






Figure 1. Turn-On Time





Figure 3. Capacitances

Figure 4. Charge Data






Figure 5. Turn-On Time

Figure 6. Rise Time




Figure 7. Storage Time




Figure 8. Frequency Effects




Figure 9. Source Resistance Effects

selected from the 2N4403 lines, and the same units were used to develop the correspondingly–numbered curves on each graph.




Figure 10. Current Gain




Figure 11. Input Impedance




Figure 12. Voltage Feedback Ratio




Figure 13. Output Admittance




Figure 14. DC Current Gain




Figure 15. Collector Saturation Region






Figure 16. "On" Voltages




**Figure 17. Temperature Coefficients**


