


Figure 1. Typical Forward Voltage

Figure 2. Maximum Forward Voltage




Figure 3. Typical Reverse Current





Figure 4. Typical Capacitance




Figure 5. Current Derating - Junction to Lead

Figure 6. Forward Power Dissipation




Figure 7. Thermal Response - Junction to Case






Figure 8. Thermal Response - Junction to Ambient




